The Highland Rotary graciously donated the money for the lights. Next step is to submit the order to Margaret, Confidential Secretary to the Supervisor.

- a. **Shed Bids**-Three bids were submitted for the committee to look over. After careful consideration the committee decided their number one choice was Grey's Woodworks 12x12 Heritage Mini Barn.
